• REVENUE LOSS

Revenues lost and not recouped due to event cancellations, closures, or loss of sales due to COVID-19. Documentation and continuing business plan required.

• PPE/COVID-19 MITIGATION

Expenses for masks, gloves, cleaning, sanitation, & in-store traffic signage may be reimbursed; receipts required.

• COLLABORATION

Programs that will help multiple entities by collaborating together to provide an innovative resource that will help the community and all organizations recover from COVID-19.

ELIGIBILITY

- ✓ Small business or non-profit
- ✓ Located in Barber County
- ✓ Must have been in business by March 16, 2020 and must still be in business with no plans to close
- ✓ Must demonstrate negative impacts from COVID-19
- ✓ Must attest that information submitted is correct and is in alignment with approved uses; expense reports required
- ✓ Must certify that expenses were not reimbursed from other grant funding
- ❖ Businesses that received PPP, EIDL, or CDBG may apply, but preference will be given to those that have not received other aid.
